

Club Sports Tier System

- I. First Tier: Club can receive a minimum of \$1,000 and a maximum of \$1,999.
 - The following requirements must be met to classify and maintain as Tier 1.
 - 1. Maintain at least 5 current members in the club.
 - 2. Have Officer(s) attend the Annual Meeting at beginning of year.
 - 3. Club Participation in at least 2 University functions.
 - 4. Participation in at least 1 match / tournament against other university club teams.
 - Clubs starting off in first year or being revived again will start here.
- II. Second Tier: Club can receive a minimum of \$1,999 and a maximum of \$2,999.
 - The following requirements must be met to classify and maintain as Tier 2.
 - 1. Maintain at least 10 current members in the club.
 - 2. Have Officer(s) attend the Annual Meeting at beginning of year.
 - 3. Club Participation in at least 2 University functions.
 - 4. In good standing with Student Life and Engagement Office and Club is actively registered on Student Group Management platform
 - 5. Participation in at least 3 matches / tournaments against other university club teams.
- III. Third Tier: Club can receive a minimum of \$2,999 and a maximum of \$3,999.
 - The following requirements must be met to classify and maintain as Tier 3.
 - 1. Maintain at least 10 current members in the club.
 - 2. Have Officer(s) attend the Annual Meeting at beginning of year.
 - 3. Club Participation in at least 2 University functions.
 - 4. Participation in at least 3 matches / tournaments / scrimmages against other university club teams.
 - 5. In good standing with Student Life and Engagement Office and Club is actively registered on Student Group Management platform
 - 6. Club Participation in 1 organized and approved Community Service Event
- IV. Fourth Tier: Club can receive a minimum of \$3,999 and a maximum of \$4,999.
 - The following requirements must be met to classify and maintain as Tier 4.
 - 1. Maintain at least 15 current members in the club.
 - 2. Have Officer(s) attend the Annual Meeting at beginning of year.
 - 3. Club Participation in at least 3 University functions .
 - 4. Participation in at least 5 matches / tournaments / scrimmages against other university club teams.
 - 5. In good standing with Student Life and Engagement Office and Club is actively registered on Student Group Management platform
 - 6. Club Participation in 1 organized and approved Community Service Event

- V. Fifth Tier: Club can receive a minimum of \$4,999 and a maximum of \$6,999.
 - The following requirements must be met to classify and maintain as Tier 3.
 - 1. Maintain at least 15 current members in the club.
 - 2. Have Officer(s) attend Annual the Meeting at beginning of year.
 - 3. Club Participation in at least 3 University functions.
 - 4. Participation in at least 10 matches / tournaments / scrimmages against other university club teams.
 - 5. In good standing with Student Life and Engagement Office and Club is actively registered on Student Group Management platform
 - 6. Club Participation in 1 organized and approved Community Service Event

Notes for the Tier System:

- Each club needs to be using university approved Club Sport logos. If university approved logos are not used, clubs could face university-imposed sanctions.
- Examples of University functions include:
 - 1. Move-in Day
 - 2. Get on Board Day
 - 3. Rec Fest
 - 4. Freshmen Orientations
 - 5. Big Event
- Examples of Community Service Events:
 - 1. Move-in Day
 - 2. Big event
- Please be prepared to provide documentation or photographic evidence of your group's participation I any of the above listed events.
- Each Club Sport should strive to set up their own off campus bank account to deal with funds the group collects
